# **Instruction Sheet**

# **Description**

This armchair table has a modern, curved laminated teak table top that is easily adjusted in height and angle. For additional comfort, it comes with a stylish side table to accommodate refreshments, which can be fitted to either the left or right hand side of the table. Lockable castors are also provided.

#### Intended Uses

Designed to be used with an armchair. To provide the user with extra surface area for feeding, drinking, writing and reading. Ideal for those with impaired movement.

# **Assembly Instructions**

- To assemble the frame (see fig.1) fit the upright tubes
  (B) to the frame (C) using the M8x20 hand wheels.
  Slot the adjustable leg sections (D) onto the upright tubes.
- 2. Insert the M8x50 hand wheels through the nuts and through the holes on the upright tubes. Please ensure the holes correspond with the opposite side otherwise the table will not be level.
- 3. Tighten all the hand wheels.
- 4. Turn the table onto its feet.
- 5. Fit the cup holder bracket ensuring buttons locate, then fit an M8x20 hand wheel tightening the cup holder bracket in place.
- 6. Fit the cup holder and secure with an M8x20 hand wheel.



#### Instructions for use


- 1. To increase the angle of the table top (see fig.2), depress the lever (A) and raise the table section and release the lever to lock into place.
- 2. To lower the angle of the table, depress lever (A) fully and lower the table section.
- 3. To raise and lower the height of the table remove the M8x50 hand wheels, find the correct height for the user and reinsert the M8x50 hand wheels.


## **Care and Cleaning**


Designed for minimum maintenance and require the occasional wipe over with a soft cloth. Use a general purpose neutral detergent with warm water. Do not use harsh abrasives or bleach based cleaners which may cause damage or discolouration.

- · Periodically check all hand wheels are tight
- Ensure legs are placed on a level surface
